* Fees are in Canadian Dollars and are mandatory for all students enrolled at SJS and are reviewed annually and subject to change. See below for an explanation of mandatory fees and optional fees.

Mandatory School Fees

Tuition Deposit: A non-refundable Tuition Deposit of \$3,000 must be paid to secure a place for each student in the school at the point of enrolment and re-enrolment. This fee is non-refundable, and non-transferable to another student.

Student Activity Fee: This fee covers the cost of items that supplement the educational program, such as field trips, experiential learning, student council activities, the yearbook and most school supplies. This fee is non-refundable.

Education Resource Fee: A fee for textbook rental, digital education tools, technology and use of school-owned devices. Students are required to maintain and return all textbooks and school-owned devices in good condition. This fee is non-refundable.

Grade 12 Fee:

- **Graduation Fee:** A Graduation Fee of \$800 contributes to the cost of the graduate and two parents attending the graduation dinner and dance, and contributes to graduation ceremony expenses. It applies to Grade 12 students only. This fee is non-refundable.
- **IB Subject Fee:** Diploma Programme assessment fees charged by the IB organization are approximately \$1,200. These fees vary depending on the number of subjects taken for IB credit. Families pay \$1,200 upfront, and any differences are refunded to families at the end of the school year.

Optional School Fees

After-School Child Care: After-School Child Care is available for Grades K–7 students for a flat fee of \$2,600 per school year. After-School Child Care is not available for Junior Kindergarten students. Families register and pay the flat fee via mySJS annually in May for the upcoming school year. Circumstances for families may change, and withdrawals from After-School Child Care are permitted up to September 1, 2026, for a full refund. A processing fee of \$25 will be deducted from the refund. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after September 1, 2026.

For occasional care, parents may choose Drop-In After-School Child Care. Drop-in After-School Child Care is \$25 per day, subject to availability. Families are invoiced during the year for the usage of Drop-In After-School Child Care.

Hot Lunch Program: Families may order hot lunch for Junior Kindergarten to Grade 7 students. The school's hot lunch program is managed by parent volunteers and administered by the Munch-a-Lunch online platform. Costs for the program will vary depending on meal selections. Payments are processed directly by the ordering platform and are not managed by the school.

New Students

New students will be required to pay the following fees in addition to the 2026–2027 School Fees:

- **Registration Fee:** A one-time fee of \$3,000 per newly enrolled JK to Grade 12 student due upon acceptance of an Offer of Admission. This fee is non-refundable.
- **Enrolment Fee:** A one-time fee per newly enrolled JK to Grade 10 student of \$9,000 for the first child enrolled at SJS, or \$6,000 for the second child enrolled at SJS. No enrolment fee is charged for each subsequent child from the same household. This fee is due upon acceptance of an Offer of Admission.

International Students

In addition to mandatory School Fees, students who are not domestic, as defined by the Ministry of Education under the School Act for the per-student operating grant funding, **must pay an International Student Fee of \$8,100 per student per year, reviewed annually and subject to change.**

- Full School Fees and all other applicable fees are due immediately upon acceptance of an Offer of Enrolment.
- For re-enrolling international students, the tuition deposit is due upon the point of re-enrolment. The balance of full tuition and all applicable fees is due on May 29, 2026.
- If an international student withdraws during the school year, SJS must notify Immigration Canada. Families are responsible for informing SJS and providing supporting documents for residency status changes during the year.

- The International Student Fee will be refunded provided that the student has not attended SJS for any part of the school year. There are no partial refunds for any part of the school year.

Payment Due Dates

All applicable fees must be received to secure a space at SJS for the new school year. SJS will not enrol or re-enrol any student until these fees have been fully paid. Ongoing or repeated late payment of fees may affect a family's eligibility for enrolment or re-enrolment.

Tuition Deposit and New Student Fees: For re-enrolling SJS students, the tuition deposit is due at the point of re-enrolment. For new students, the tuition deposit, new student fee and enrolment fee, where applicable, are due immediately upon acceptance of an Offer of Admission. For new international students, full tuition and all applicable fees are due immediately upon acceptance of an Offer of Admission.

School Fees: The balance of School Fees (excluding the tuition deposit) is due in full or submitted in accordance with the instalment schedule (detailed below) by May 29, 2026.

Early Payment Discounts: An early payment discount of **1%** will be applied to Tuition Fee paid in full on or before **May 15, 2026**.

Sibling Discounts: A sibling discount of **3%** is applied to the Tuition Fee of the youngest sibling enrolled in SJS. Any applicable discounts will be reflected on the invoice uploaded to the student's mySJS Files and Forms at the end of March.

Late Payments: Late payment interest at 1.50% per month (18% per annum) will be applied to outstanding balances if received after May 29, 2026. All NSF cheques will be charged an administrative fee of \$25 on the first NSF cheque, \$50 on the second NSF and \$100 on subsequent NSF cheques.

Payment Methods

All payments must be paid in Canadian dollars.

Cheques: Cheques should be payable to "SJS St. John's School Society".

If paying by instalments, post-dated cheques must be provided by May 29, 2026.

Bill Payment: SJS accepts online bill payments for School Fees from BMO, CIBC, RBC, Scotiabank and TD Bank. Parents wishing to pay as an online bill payment must add **SJS St. John's School Society** as a Canadian payee and enter the student's **HOST ID** as the account number. **The student's HOST ID can be found on current and past SJS School Fees invoices via mySJS.** If paying by installments, please schedule payments as per the table above.

Credit Card Payment: Credit card payments can be arranged through a member of the Finance team. Please contact finance@sjs.ca to schedule a payment time. A 2.40% processing fee will be applied to the payment of School Fees, except for re-enrolment tuition deposits.

International Wire Transfer: Families living abroad or without a Canadian bank account can make wire transfers. A \$50 processing fee is charged for wire transfers—please add the \$50 processing fee to the wire transfer amount. Wire transfer information is detailed in the [SJS bank details](#). If paying by international wire transfer, please email finance@sjs.ca to confirm the date and time of payment so that the Finance team can track the payment.

Cash: SJS will not accept cash payments of \$1,000 or more in a single transaction for any purpose. Additionally, SJS will not accept more than \$1,000 in cash per school year per family. Single transactions equal to or more than \$500 from a family will require additional procedures by SJS to verify identification and source of funds.
